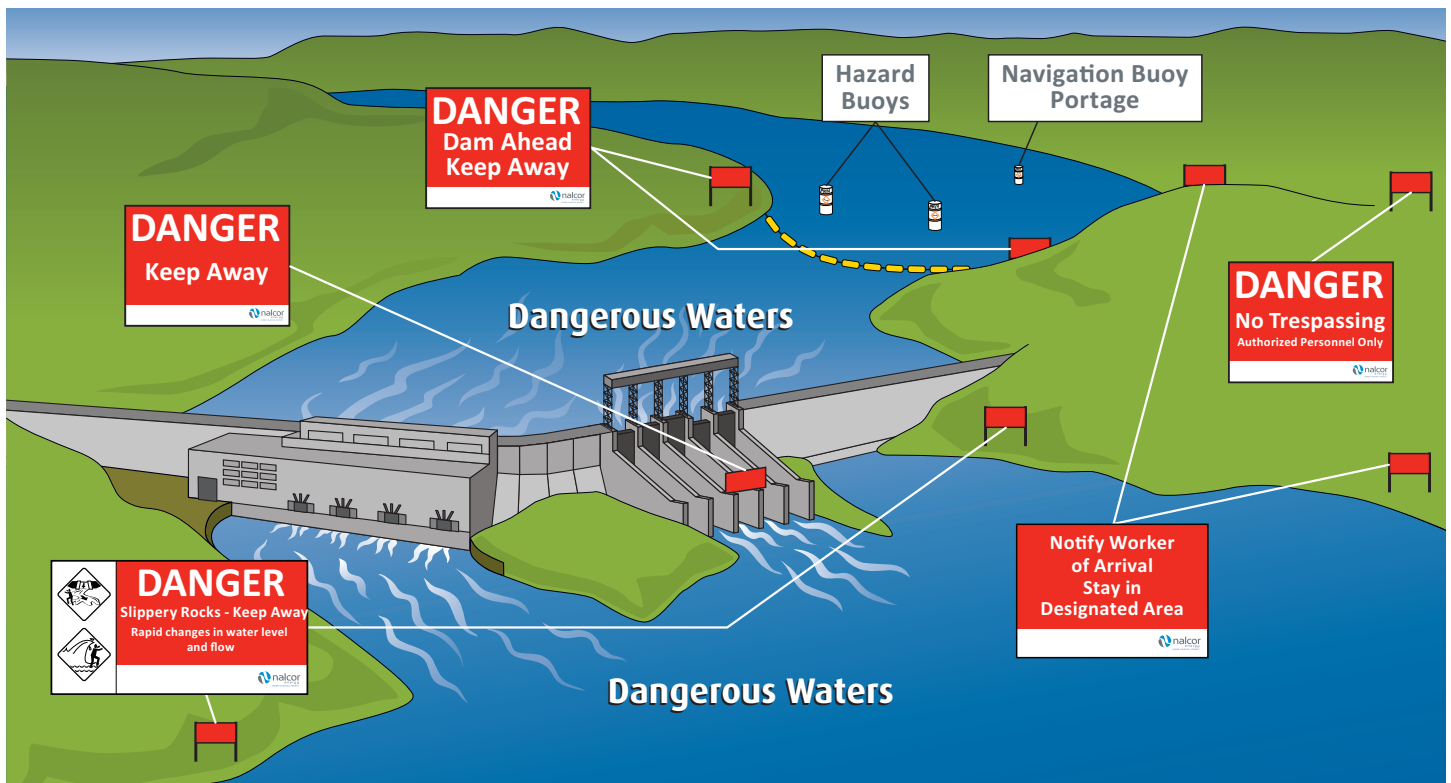


# Muskrat Falls Project

## Important Safety Information



### Stay safe around hydroelectric facilities. Watch for signs and be aware of the hazards.

The Muskrat Falls facility will be marked with safety signs. There will also be fences, buoys, booms and barriers to keep you a safe distance away. If you are in the lower Churchill River valley, here's what you should do to stay safe:

- ⚠️ Avoid waterways upstream and downstream of generating facilities whether open water or ice covered.
- ⚠️ Obey all danger and warning signs and stay a safe distance from booms and hazard buoys.
- ⚠️ Stay well back from the edge of a waterway or steep slopes along the reservoir. These areas may be slippery or unstable.
- ⚠️ Be aware of changing water levels.
- ⚠️ Never stand, anchor or tie your boat below a dam. Water levels and flows can change rapidly, swamping your boat or putting you in an undertow.
- ⚠️ Be cautious of dry areas below dams. Water levels can quickly change and exposed sandbars can become submerged.
- ⚠️ Stay away from generating facility structures.
- ⚠️ Do not enter secured areas or tamper with equipment.
