Transportation of transformers for the Lower Churchill Project

Starting July 26, Mammoet Canada will be transporting seven transformers from Cartwright in southern Labrador to the Muskrat Falls Project site on Route 510 just outside Happy Valley – Goose Bay.

The transformers will be moved in four shipments, and the transportation of each load will take approximately eight days.

The equipment will be travelling at slow speeds using Main Road Cartwright, Route 516 and Route 510 on the Trans-Labrador Highway. Drivers are advised that each convoy moving the shipments will be approximately one kilometre in length. Safety First will travel with each shipment to provide traffic management and maintain the flow of traffic.

Motorists are asked to keep safety in mind when approaching a shipment. Transportation updates will be provided regularly on Nalcor Energy's Facebook and Twitter pages noted below.
