



PUBLIC SAFETY AROUND THE MUSKRAT FALLS FACILITY

Be safe when taking part in activities close to the Muskrat Falls facility.

There are dangers associated with dams and hydroelectric facilities, so please use caution when taking part in recreational activities close to the Muskrat Falls facilities.

Higher flows: At this time, there are higher flows and unpredictable currents.

Natural hazards in the river: As snow and ice continue to melt in the woods and along the riverbanks, ice and debris, such as trees and stumps, enter into the river and proceed downstream.

For your safety:

- ▲ Obey danger signs that point out potential hazards.
- ▲ Stay away from the facilities as there is a strong water force upstream and downstream of the spillway.
- ▲ Be aware of rapid changes in water levels and flows.
- ▲ Stay a safe distance from the river's edge and steep banks along the reservoir as they may be slippery and unstable.
