



Public Notice August 27, 2015:

Transportation of materials for the Muskrat Falls Project

Nalcor Energy advises the public that until the end of October, shipments of materials will travel from the port in Happy Valley–Goose Bay to Muskrat Falls Project sites on Route 510. The equipment will be transported by standard transport trucks as well as trucks that carry heavy and wide loads. The route will be from the port, via Hamilton River Road and the Trans-Labrador Highway route 510. The trucks will be carrying transmission line components as well as large pieces of equipment for the hydroelectric generating plant.

For oversized loads, the company transporting the materials is following strict safety protocols. Oversized loads will only be moved following safety conditions outlined in permits issued by the provincial government.
