Transportation of materials from port to the Muskrat Falls site

Nalcor Energy advises the public there will be two oversized transport loads that will travel from the port in Happy Valley-Goose Bay to the Muskrat Falls Project site via Hamilton River Road and the Trans-Labrador Highway route 510. The transportation of equipment will include a wide and heavy load that will be travelling at slow speeds which will disrupt traffic flow during the move.

The transport is planned by the contractor and will take place on Saturday, October 31 and Monday, November 2, 2015. The contractor plans to leave the Happy Valley-Goose Bay port around 11:30 am and arrive at Veterans Memorial Bridge around 1:00 pm. Traffic will be stopped for 15 to 30 minutes while the equipment is transported over Veterans Memorial Bridge.

For oversized loads, the company transporting the materials will follow strict safety protocols. Oversized loads will only be moved following safety conditions outlined in permits issued to the contractor by the provincial government.
