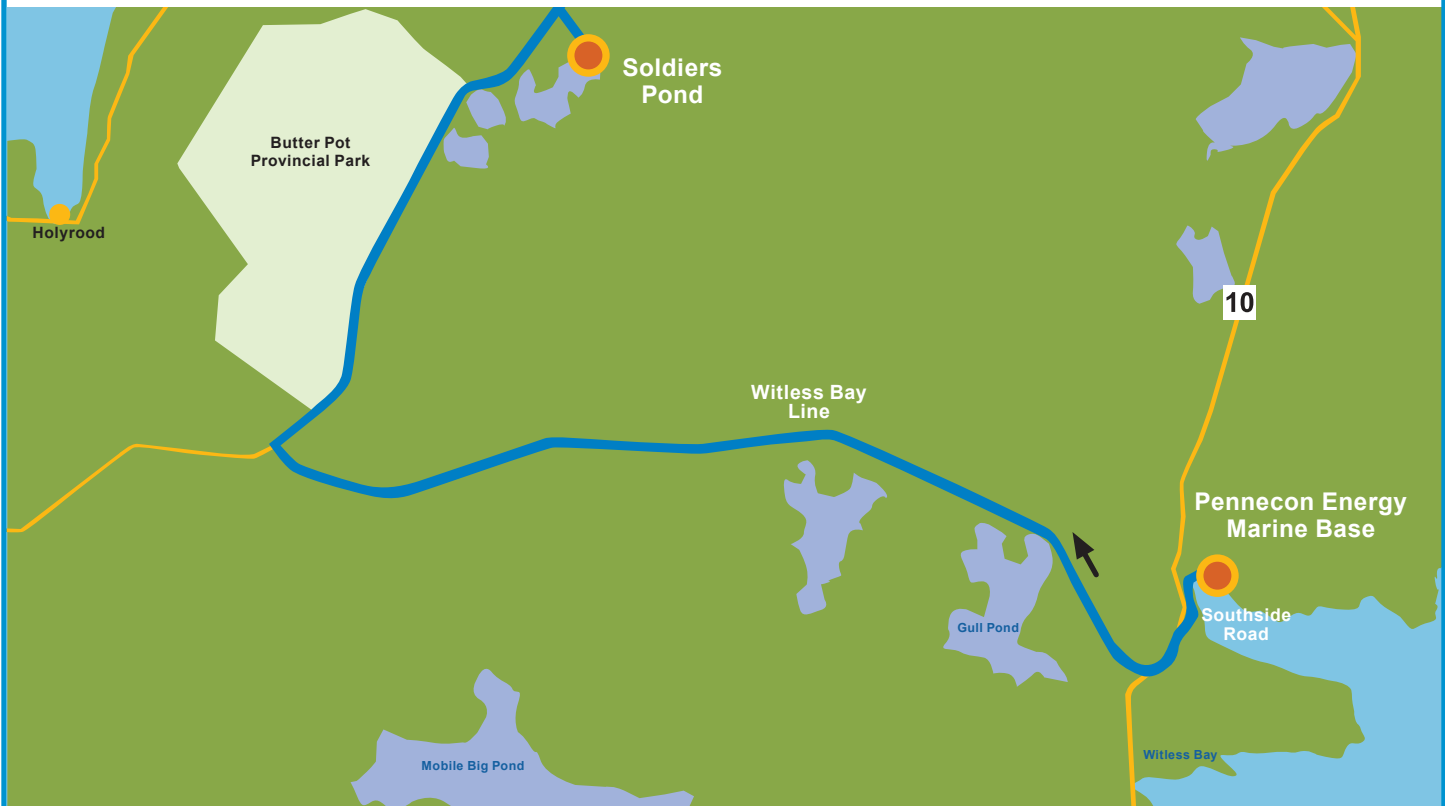

Muskrat Falls Project – Heavy Equipment Move From Bay Bulls to Soldiers Pond Construction Site



Update on Equipment Moves from Bay Bulls to Soldiers Pond Transformer move planned for April 13

Mammoet Canada will be transporting a transformer from the Pennecon Energy Marine Base in Bay Bulls to Soldiers Pond on Thursday, April 13, starting at 10 AM.

*This date and time is weather dependent and will be updated if there is a change.

Given the size of the equipment being moved, the following route, Southside Road, Route 10 (Main Road), Witless Bay Line and Trans-Canada Highway (East Bound), will have temporary traffic stoppages and slow moving traffic.

The approximate timing for traffic stoppages and slow moving traffic along the route is as follows:

- Southside Road: 10:15 AM – 10:30 AM
- Route 10 (Main Road): 10:30 AM – 10:45 AM
- Witless Bay Line: 10:45 AM – 11:15 AM *Slow moving traffic
- Trans-Canada Highway (East Bound): 11:15 AM – 11:30 AM *Slow moving traffic
