



PUBLIC SAFETY NOTICE

Important lower Churchill River safety information

For your safety, people are advised not to use the river between Edwards Island and the Muskrat Falls facility as there are increased safety concerns during the dewatering process. Boaters are advised to exit the river near Edwards Island. Signs have been placed on the river advising river users where to safely exit.

If you are around the Muskrat Falls facility, here's what you should do to stay safe:

- ⚠️ Obey all danger signs along the river which point out potential hazards.
- ⚠️ Do not enter active construction sites and avoid the area near the facility as there is a strong water force upstream and downstream.
- ⚠️ Stay a safe distance from the edge of the river and steep banks along the reservoir as they may be slippery or unstable.
