

SAFETY NOTICE:

Ride safely when travelling near active transmission construction sites

Construction of the Labrador – Island Transmission Link for the Muskrat Falls Project is ongoing across the province, covering more than 1,100 km from Muskrat Falls to St. John's. That's a lot of country. So we need your help to keep you, and our construction crews, safe.

With increased construction activity, heavy equipment and trucks are operating regularly on transmission line access roads to transport equipment and materials.

For your safety and the safety of workers, please respect restricted areas and posted safety signage, and always use caution when travelling near construction areas.

Be safe near construction sites:

- Make yourself visible
- Respect posted safety signage and restricted areas
- Remember that hunting is not permitted in active construction zones
- Watch for heavy equipment and machinery
- Be cautious of material and equipment that may be covered
