Water Levels

The safety and health of people living and working in and around the Muskrat Falls facilities is our number one priority.

Over the last week we've been preparing for the installation of the safety boom in the river upstream of the spillway. To ensure the safety of the people installing the safety boom, water levels have been raised to around 21.7 m upstream of the spillway. With this water level reached, work has now started on installing the safety boom.
