
Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, Labrador – Island Link Limited Partnership has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry numbers 1522-1548 and 1550-1576, a description of the following works, sites and plans:

-work includes the replacement/upgrade of existing culverts to larger culverts or a bridge, in/across various streams, at various locations throughout Labrador, in the general vicinity of the Labrador – Island Transmission line right-of-way. See Registry for exact locations of each upgrade/replacement.
