

MUSKRAT FALLS COVID-19 TRAVEL BULLETIN

May 1, 2020



Information for May 4 Rotation Change for MF Essential Workers

Please note the following important protocols for workers travelling via charter flights to Happy Valley-Goose Bay for essential work at the Muskrat Falls site:

- Physical distancing is factored in to seating arrangements on the chartered flights as well as the MF Project buses.
- Once you arrive at the Goose Bay Airport, you are not permitted to visit Upper Lake Melville.
- Travel from the Goose Bay Airport to the MF site is only permitted on designated MF Project buses.
- Once you arrive at the Goose Bay Airport, you will be met by a LCP manager. You will be escorted directly to a MF Project bus. The bus will travel directly to the MF site.
- Once you arrive at the MF site, you are required to stay at site for the two-week duration of your rotation. Travel is not permitted back and forth to town, except for emergency reasons.

During the COVID-19 pandemic Nalcor has put a number of measures in place for the Muskrat Falls Project to ensure people's health and safety while protecting the community.
